

TEMPORARY TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT ORDER OF BLACK MOOR ROAD, VERWOOD

DORSET COUNCIL has made an Order under Section 14 [1] of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984 as amended. The Order is needed in order to comply with health and safety regulations which require the provision of safe working areas and to minimise the likelihood of danger to highway users. It will come into operation on 11 September 2023 and will remain in force for 18 months, however it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 13 October 2023.

This Order will enable National Grid Company safe access to carry out overhead line refurbishment works.

The effect of this Order is as follows:

- [i] To impose a temporary road closure on; BLACK MOOR ROAD, VERWOOD - from its northern junction with Ringwood Road to its junction with Rosebery Close.
- [ii] To impose a clearway and parking suspension as indicated by signs on site (Orange on the map below) to prevent waiting or parking on the highway along; BLACK MOOR ROAD, VERWOOD from its southern junction with B3081 Ringwood Road to its junction with Bessemer Close.

Any vehicle waiting in contravention of any restriction imposed by this Notice may be removed under the provisions of the Removal and Disposal of Vehicles Regulations 1986. A locally signed diversion route will be put in place to enable traffic to travel around the closed sections.
